taco dinner.**

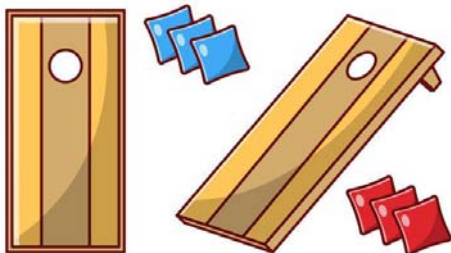
